

Grave restauration on Jewish Cementary Hemsbach

This was a tour, very different and exceptional. But aren't all ancestry tours individual and exceptional?

What was the request?

I got a mail through ToursByLocals, one of the systems were I am registered.

A client had a 5 hours stopover at the Frankfurt airport and wanted to use that time to visit the family graves on the old Jewish Cementary in Hemsbach, Odenwald. On the cementary our client wanted to meet a stonemason who should have a look at the grave stones as our client wanted them to be restored. As there was just very little time between the two flights everything needed to be organized in advance.

What we did:

We wrote the client that it takes about an hour to drive from Frankfurt airport to the Hemsbach cementary, so we would have just 1,5 hour maximum to look for the graves. We contacted the stonemason, made an appointment for the meeting.

Everything worked out brilliant. We walked through this impressive cementary with the old grave stones, by the help of a list we found the grave-stones real quick and everything necessary was arranged on the spot.
